2026 Shanghai Summer School: Comparative Governance Program for Neighboring Countries (the “Program”) is sponsored by Shanghai Municipal Education Commission and organized by School of International Relations and Public Affairs (“SIRPA”), Fudan University.

Introduction

Since July 2017, SIRPA has jointly launched the Advanced Training Program for Young Diplomatic Talents from Belt and Road Countries. As of 2025, eight cohorts have been held, enrolling a total of 112 participants from 44 Belt and Road countries. Commissioned by the Shanghai Municipal People’s Government and the Shanghai Municipal Education Commission, this program serves as a key strategic initiative to support the Belt and Road Initiative. It aims to strengthen people-to-people ties between young diplomats, civil servants, and social elites from Belt and Road countries and China, and to deepen their understanding of China’s development strategy and Shanghai’s role in global urban governance.

The 2026 Shanghai Summer School: Comparative Governance Program for Neighboring Countries is an extension of this initiative. The program maintains a sustained focus on the theme of *Consensus, Co-prosperity, and Sharing*, aligning with the internationalization strategy of China’s Double First-Class Initiative and the development of political science as a leading discipline. It also constitutes an innovative model of disciplinary collaboration, in which local youth scholars and students are jointly recruited by partner institutions, leading faculty members from the SIRPA are assigned to deliver instruction, and academic exchange between Fudan’s political science scholars and their counterparts in neighboring countries is significantly broadened.



Curriculum

The curriculum is comprised of five modules: *Chinese modernization & Chinese Governance System, Chinese Development and Global Governance, Chinese Diplomacy and Construction of a Community with a Shared Future, National Conditions of Belt and Road & Neighboring Countries, and Inheritance and Modernization of Chinese Culture*. The Program takes the form of lectures, seminars and workshops. Leading experts, senior diplomats and practical specialists may be invited. The working language of the Program is **English**.
