Why join the DTU Global Talent Programme?

The DTU Global Talent Programme gives you the opportunity to spend one or two semesters in Denmark, working on real research projects at DTU or gaining hands-on experience through an internship with a DTU industry partner. As a top-performing undergraduate student, you will develop academic, professional, and intercultural skills in a world-class research and innovation environment — and gain experience that can shape your future studies and career.

What you gain from the programme:

- International academic or industry experience in Denmark
- Hands-on research or internship experience linked to real projects
- Stronger academic and professional profile
- Valuable international network and intercultural skills

Who can apply and what does DTU offer?

You can apply if you

- Are a top 10% undergraduate student in your 3rd or 4th year
- Are nominated by your home university based on grades, extracurricular activities, and relevant experience
- Can commit to one or two semesters
- Have a background relevant to STEM-related fields
- Have strong English skills (English proficiency test passed with strong results)

What DTU provides:

- Matching to placements based on your interests and competence profile
- Guidance on housing options and residence permits in Denmark
- A strong social, cultural, and professional framework, including networking and social activities
- Opportunities for supplementary academic elements, such as coursework and DTU supervision, where compatible

How to apply and what happens next

Application process:

- 1 March 2026: Project and internship postings become available (a guide on how to submit your application via DTU's Career Hub will be provided at the end of February)
- Discuss your interest with your home university
- 15 April 2026: Nomination and application deadline – you must be nominated by your home university and submit your application

What happens next:

- You will participate as part of your university's existing exchange agreement
- If applicable, you may join as an Erasmus+ Traineeship student
- DTU confirms participation and provides further guidance
