

Program Overview

- Hands-on full-time research at a partner university abroad
- 8 -16 weeks between May and August
- 30 - 40 hours full-time research (no other courses can be taken)
- Supervised by faculty at the host institution
- Non-credit or UofT courses (PCL/CSB/HMB/APS)
- Possible field trips and social events organized by the host
- Applications via Folio
- Separate IE+ Award application (link on Folio)
- Guaranteed \$3000 for nominated students

Eligibility Requirements

- ❑ Be enrolled as a degree seeking student at the time of application, prior to departure and until program completion
 - > Students graduating in June 2025 are not eligible
- ❑ Good academic standing and have a CGPA of at least 2.25
 - > Most destinations require a higher CGPA
- ❑ Complete 2+ years of study by the time of participation
 - > Destinations that accept 1+ year students: NTU (Engineering), City University of Hong Kong, and University of Liverpool
 - > Some destinations require 3+ years of study

Eligibility:

- Enrolled as a full-time student at U of T
- Minimum cGPA 3.0
- Completed 2 years of studies by the time of participation

Application Deadline: November 24th, 2024

Required Documents: Motivation Letter, Resume, Transcript of Records, Letter of Recommendation and Declaration of Insurance.

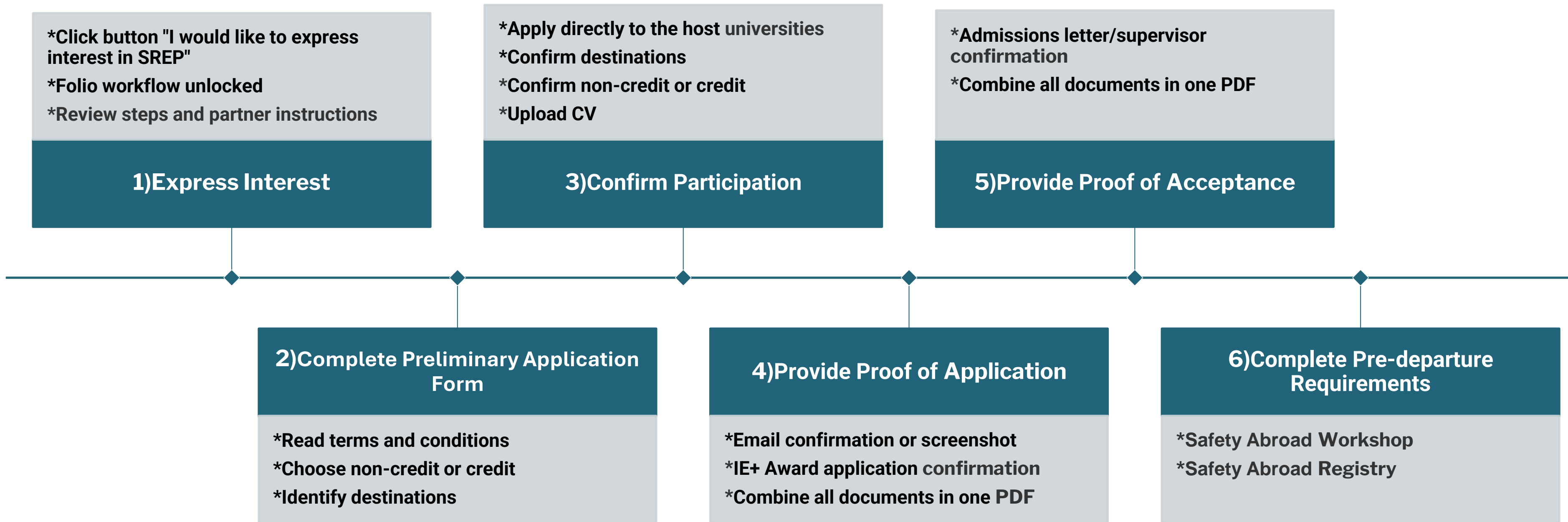
