

# Common questions

## Important timelines?

- Non-credit: partner deadlines
- For-credit (PCL/CSB/HMB/APS):  
November 29
- Rolling admissions: apply early

## How many universities can students apply to?

- Up to 2 universities
- Some partners allow students to apply for multiple projects

## How competitive it is?

- SREP is a competitive program and nomination is not guaranteed
- Number of applicants/academic background/existing connections, etc.

## Fees?

- No **tuition** fees paid to the host
- Non-credit – UofT incidental fees only
- UofT credit – UofT tuition
- Some universities charge program fees

# Common questions

## Can I do SREP more than once?

- Yes, it's possible
- Maximum 3 terms of exchange during undergraduate

## Master's students?

- SREP is an undergraduate program

## International students?

- Yes, all learning abroad opportunities are open to both domestic & international

## Can I do SREP in my 4th year?

- Not eligible if you are graduating in June
- Must remain full-time degree seeking students until completion

## Can I do both non-credit and for-credit?

- No
- Only one application and one stream
- Duplicate applications will not be processed

# Common questions

## How to get nominated?

- Do you need credit?
- Strong application
- Be able to secure a supervisor
- No academic offences
- Not guaranteed

## How to find supervisors?

- Refer to institutional instructions
- Projects/Faculty directory
- Good communication skills

## Application process for a specific university?

- Instructions on Folio
- Stage "Confirm Participation" – application instructions
- Book a Folio appointment

## Do partner universities help in finding a supervisor?

- Some level of support
- Student's responsibility to secure a supervisor

# Common questions

## Research destinations in humanities & social science?

- Partners that have no program restrictions
- NTU/Humboldt/Darmstadt/Graz/Konstanz/Goethe/HKUST

## Universities that accept 1st year students?

- National Taiwan University (Engineering)
- City University of Hong Kong
- University of Liverpool

## Importance of GPA and previous research experience?

- CGPA is important but not the only parameter
- Previous research experience not required
- Highlight relevant courses/experiences on CV
